At our April Meeting Floridalma Boj Lopez will speak on her research revolving around thinking about the Guatemalan Maya community in Angeles. Floridalma is an American Fellowship recipient working on her Ph.D. in Sociology and Indigenous Studies at USC. She will explain how the Guatemalan Maya community create forms of memory through culture practice. Her work brings together Native American Studies, Latino Studies and Latin American Studies in an effort to analyze the experiences of Maya migrants as they encounter settler colonialism in the United States while facing intra-Latino racism from their non-indigenous counterparts.

A truly "green" hike as eleven happy hikers hiked up Lake Trail to Barbara's Lake. Along the way, we saw large plaques with original plein-air paintings by local artists. From Lake Trail, over to Edison Trail and down Canyon Trail which challenged our balance and stability! Along the way there was a patch of blooming prickly-pear cactus. We wrapped up our great day with a delicious lunch and a spectacular view at Strawberry Farms Golf Club.

Thursday, April 6, 2017, Happy Hikers will go to Riley Wilderness Park which is a wildlife sanctuary. The park has two stream-fed canyons, rolling hills and two overlooks. The seasonal creeks are lined with Western sycamores and ancient coastal live oaks, where coastal sage scrub and grasslands carpet the hills. The hike will be a 3-mile loop, elevation gain 300 feet. The trails we will take are Wagon Wheel Canyon, Pheasant Run, Oak Canyon Loop to Mule Deer Trail. Wildflowers such as shooting star, lupine, wild hyacinth and monkey flowers should be in bloom. There is a \$3 parking fee.

Our Guided tour: 11:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m., Thursday, April 13. We will carpool from Coco's on Valley View at 9:00 a.m. Quest will travel to downtown Los Angeles to take a fascinating tour of the historic LA Times Headquarters.

When the Times building opened in 1935, it was the largest building in the western US designed and occupied entirely as a daily newspaper publishing operation. The building also won a gold medal at the 1937 Paris Exposition for its Moderne architectural style. We will have a guided one hour tour of the main editorial areas of this great Art Deco building. With an hour filled with journalistic anecdotes, we will learn about the history of the newspaper as well as a little history of Los Angeles as well. Lunch will follow at the Times cafeteria.

The Los Angeles Times is the last major newspaper to offer free public tours.
