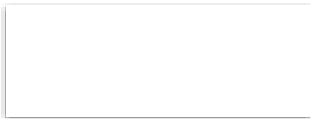

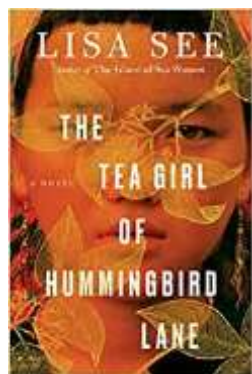
We don't have dates for these Quests (other than September 10) but here are the venues:
